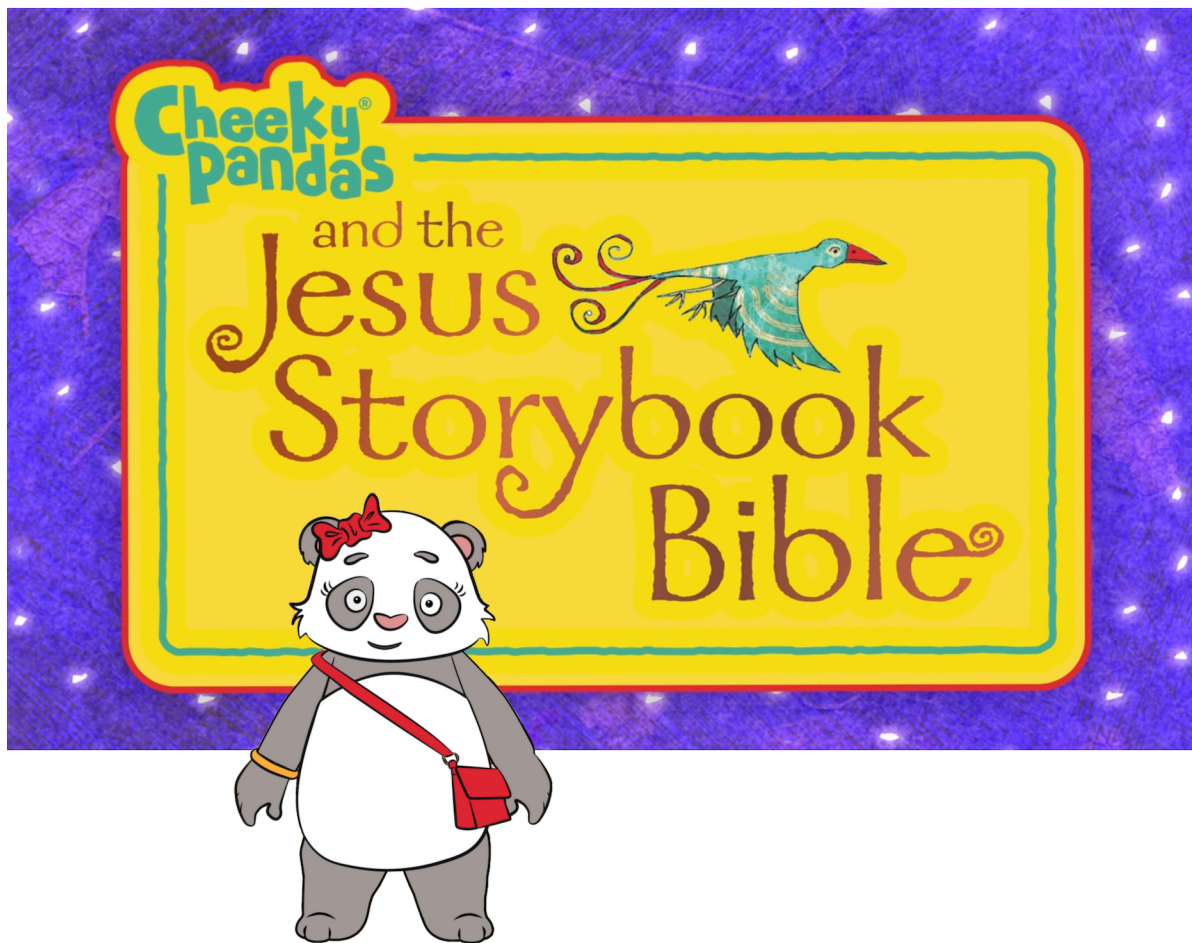

Food Challenge



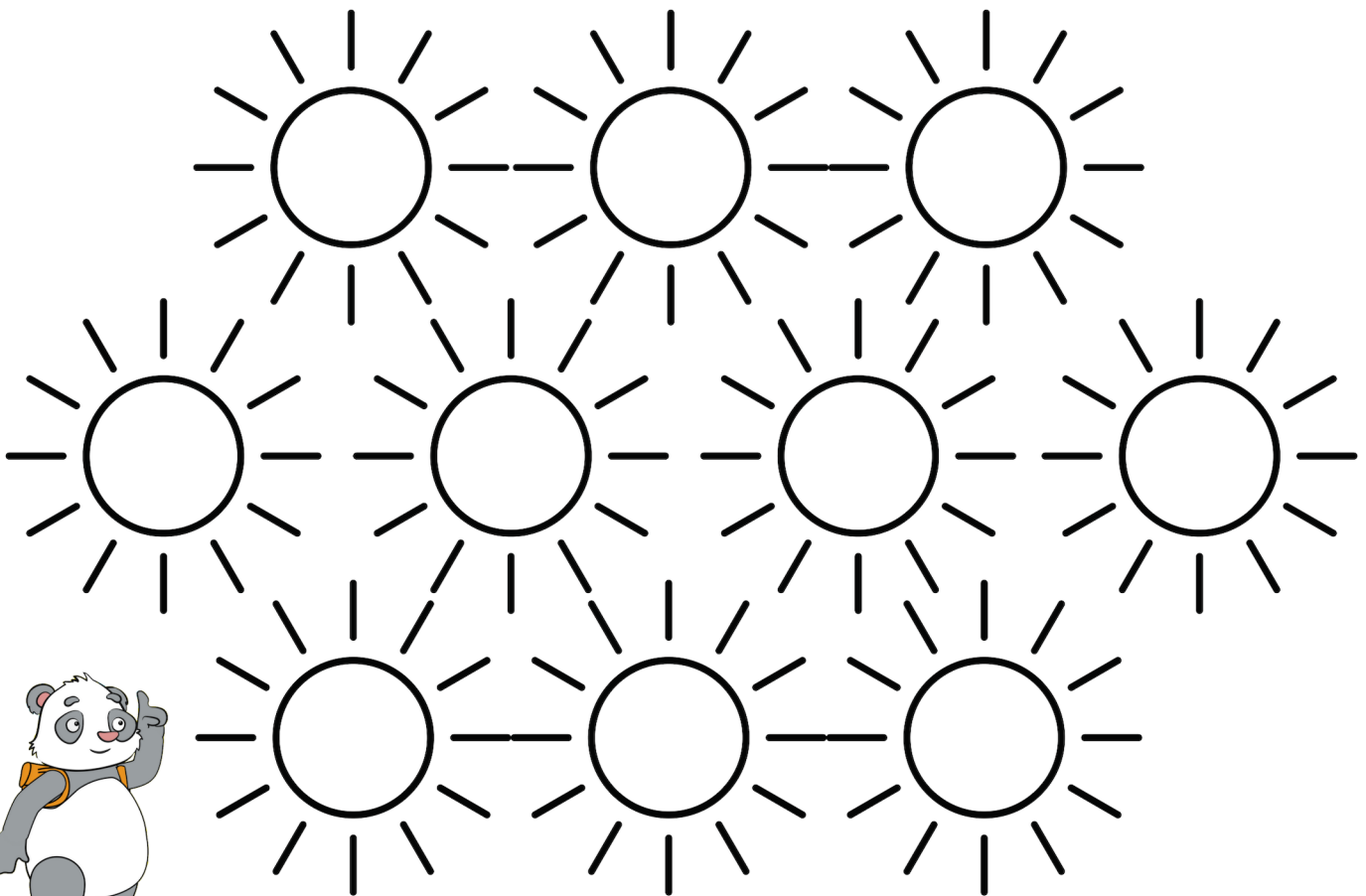
Today we are making Stormy Panda Puddings

You will need:

- Squirty cream (canned whipped cream)
- Fruit such as orange segments, bananas and apples
- Plate
- Child safe knife

1. Prepare the area for making your stormy panda pudding and wash your hands.
2. With help, cut up the fruit into pieces
3. Place your fruit on your plate to make a boat shape.
4. Then add squirty cream to make the stormy waves like in today's story.

How much do you love your Stormy Panda Pudding? Colour in the sunshines to give your pudding a score out of 10

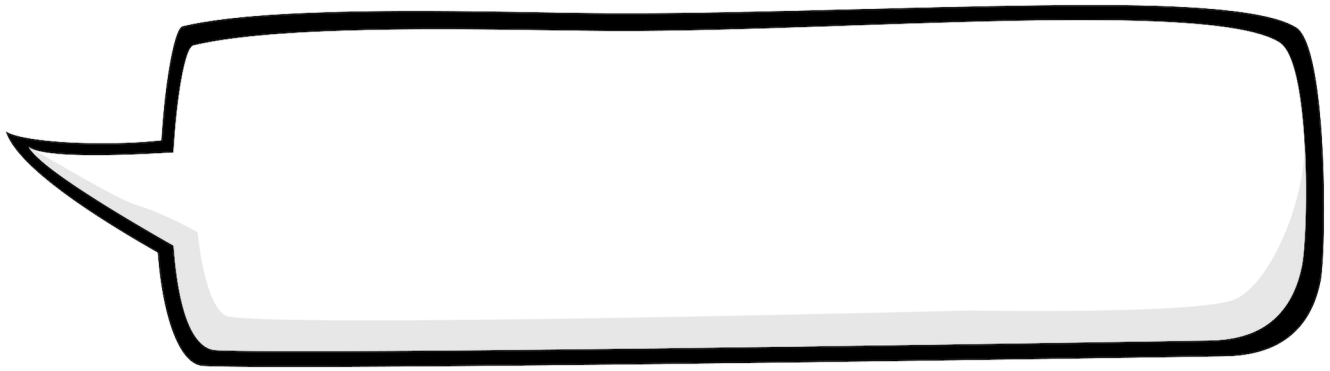


Let's Pray!

Let's make

Today we are making our own windsock!

- 1. Decorate a cardboard tube with pens and stickers.**
- 2. Cut some tissue paper into long strips, or use ribbon instead.**
- 3. Attach the tissue paper / ribbon to one end of the cardboard tube.**
- 4. Thread a piece of string through the length of the tube and tie in a loop.**
- 5. Hang your wind sock outside somewhere where it can capture the breeze and show you the wind direction. (Remember that it might go soggy if it gets wet though!).**
