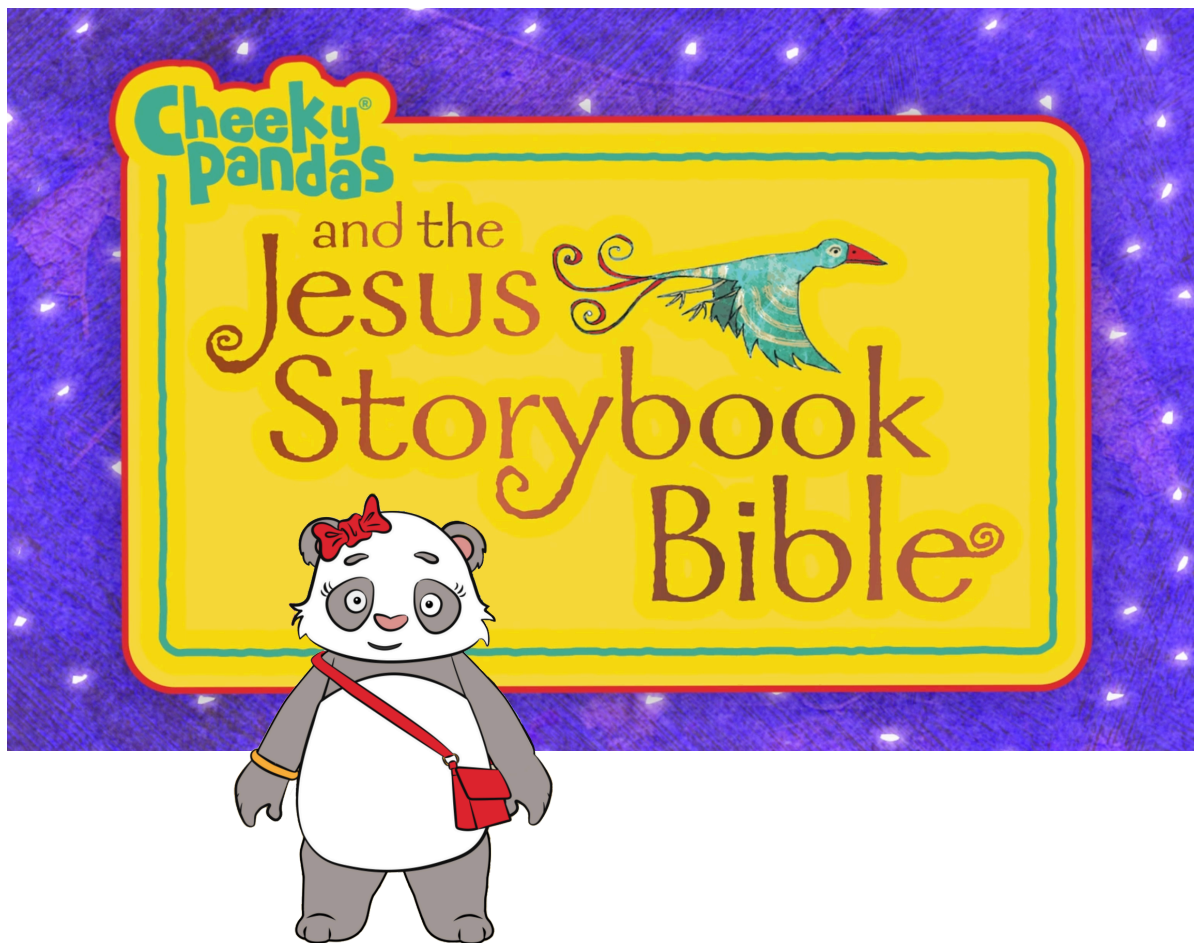

What was your favourite part of the Cheeky Pandas episode?

Why did Zacchaeus climb a tree?

Who came up to Zacchaeus to say that he was coming to Zacchaeus' house?

If Jesus wanted to be friends with Zacchaeus and show him God's love, who else do you think Jesus wants to be friends with and show God's love?

Let's Think!

When Zacchaeus met Jesus, he felt so badly about stealing from people that he decided he would pay back everyone that he stole from **FOUR TIMES what he had stole. Let's do some big thinking . . .**

If Zacchaeus stole one coin from someone, draw a coin in the remaining boxes, and then count how many coins Zacchaeus had to repay!

If Zacchaeus stole three coins from someone, draw three coins in the remaining boxes, and then count how many coins Zacchaeus had to repay!

Food Challenge



Today we are making a tree like Zacchaeus climbed!

You will need:

- Veggie Straws
- Grapes or green apple slices
- Plate

1. Get a plate and select some veggie straws.
2. Ask a grown-up to help you slice a green apple and/or use grapes.
3. Use the veggie straws as the tree trunk and branches. Make the tree as big as you'd like!
4. Add green apples or grapes as the leaves around the branches.
5. Use your fingers to pretend to be Zacchaeus climbing up the tree!
6. And then ... ENJOY!



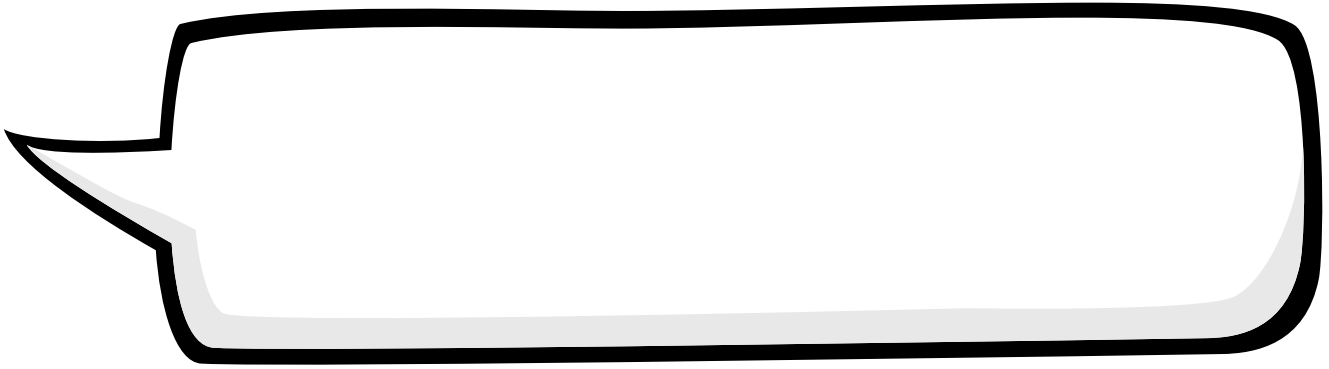

love You so much! In Jesus' name we pray, AMEN.**

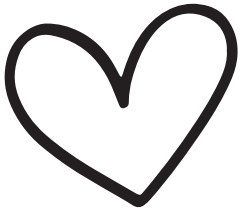
Let's make

In the story, Jesus went to Zacchaeus' house. Today you'll make a house and then imagine Jesus coming to visit you at your home!

You will need: 6 craft sticks, white glue, paper, colouring supplies

- 1. Start by making the frame of the house with the craft sticks by gluing them to the paper. First, make a triangle with the craft sticks for the roof, and then, add a square beneath it.**
- 2. Wait a few minutes to allow the glue to dry. As you do, imagine all the things you'd do with Jesus if he came to visit you at your house. Would you play with your favourite toys? Make him a snack? Go and play outdoors? Ask him lots of questions?**
- 3. When the glue is dry, write or draw some of your ideas inside the house! Outside of the house write, "If Jesus came for a visit..."**
- 4. Show your grown-ups all of the things you'd like to do with Jesus!**
